landscape forever. We kept the furnishings simple to unobtrusively frame the views and underpin the iconic Menemsha setting.

West Tisbury Family Home: this project makes an important gathering place for its owners’ active and diverse family by respecting its old country house form while minimizing the impact of achieving needed space and privacy through exacting adaptation and re-use. The centerpiece is an ingenious screen house with an enormous dining table and an elegant swinging bed. The interiors take important cues from the owners’ large collection of Vineyard artwork and affinity for color and pattern.
